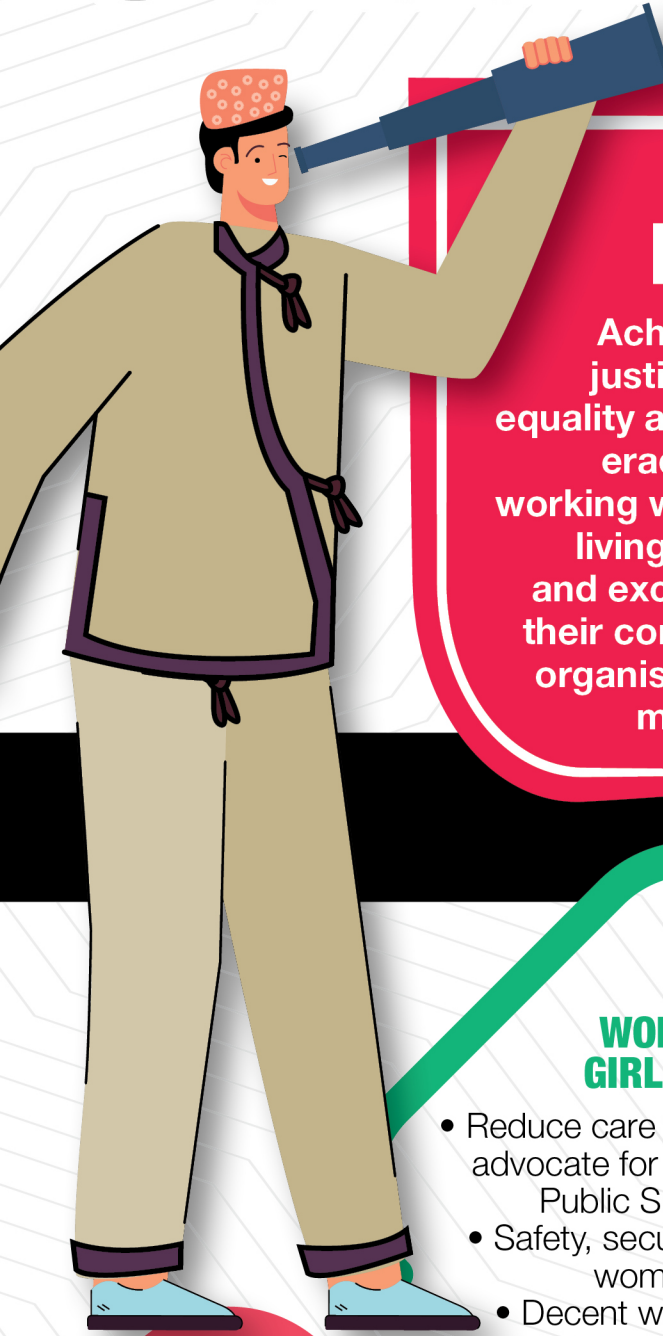


# Action for Social Justice
